

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **MATERIALS**:

- Metal-edged ruler
- Butter knife
- Scissors or craft knife
- Cutting mat (optional)
- Multipurpose glue

Score all the pieces: Using a ruler as a guide, run the back side of a butter knife firmly along all dotted lines.



Using scissors or a craft knife and cutting mat, cut out all pieces along solid lines. Be sure to cut solid black lines around nose and on sides of body.




3 Fold all pieces along score lines, using the folding key below as a reference.






4 Body: Fold and glue A tabs as indicated.



Fold and glue B tabs as indicated.




Fold and glue C tabs as indicated.




7 Fold and glue top of body closed.



- 8 Head: Fold along lines so nose stands out.
- Glue tabs on beard in place as indicated.



(1) Glue head in place on area indicated on body. Make sure head is centered.



- Insert arms into slits in body.



#### REDUCE



#### Find 2 rooms where lights have been left on and then turn them off.

**Did you know:** CFL (Compact Fluorescent Light) and LED (Light Emitting Diode) bulbs use at least 75% less energy than traditional light bulbs? How many CFL or LED bulbs can you find in your home?







#### Find 2 appliances that are plugged in but not being used, and then unplug them.

For example, check your toaster, blender, microwave, or a cell phone charger.

Did you know: In the average home, 75% of the electricity used to power electronics and appliances is consumed while the products are turned off?



#### Find your thermostat—what temperature is it set at? \_\_\_\_\_ F

**Did you know:** For every degree you lower the thermostat, you can save between 1% and 3% of your heating bill?

#### REUSE



#### Look in your closet and find 3 items of clothing that you haven't worn in the

past year. Ask your parents to take you to a local donation center so the clothing can be reused.

**Did you know:** America's landfills are filled with 7 million tons of discarded clothing each year?



**Find 3 used greeting cards.** Instead of throwing them out, cut them into bookmarks or make them into a paper chain to decorate your room. Or, cut off the side with artwork and reuse it as a postcard! **Did you know:** That 7 billion greeting cards are sent in the US each year?



#### Find 2 items in your kitchen that you could reuse to make something new.

What are they? What are some things you could make out of them?

**Did you know:** Most yogurt containers cannot be recycled? Use them as seed starters instead!

### **Find 3 things in your home that need to be recycled.** For example, junk mail, newspapers, soda cans, and plastic bottles.

**Did you know:** If everyone in the US recycled their Sunday paper, nearly 550,000 trees would be saved each week?



#### Find a discarded toilet paper roll in your bathroom wastebasket.

Add it in with your other paper recyclables.

Did you know: Toilet paper tubes can also be composted?
